Dr. Terry Eagleton is one of the best-known literary theorists and critics alive today. His book *Literary Theory: An Introduction* (1983), perhaps the most widely read guide to literary theory ever written, was recently re-published in a 25th-anniversary edition (2008). He is also the author of *Sweet Violence: The Idea of the Tragic* (2002), *How to Read a Poem* (2007), and *Trouble with Strangers: A Study of Ethics* (2008). His latest monograph, *On Evil* (Yale UP), will appear in 2010.

The 2010-11 academic year marks the fiftieth anniversary of UW's Department of English Language and Literature. In recognition of this milestone, the Department plans a year of celebrations designed to bring together alumni, students, and professors for convivial times and intellectual stimulation.
